
Spring of Harod



View looking south at the cave from which the spring of Harod rises. This, according to tradition, is the spring where Gideon chose his men to fight against the Midianites (Judges 7). In Arabic it is called Ain Jalud.

Spring of Harod



 $En \ Harod \ is \ the \ spring \ where \ Gideon \ (the \ judge) \ chose \ his \ men \ (Judg \ 7:1). \ It \ is \ identified \ with \ Ain \ Jalud.$

En (Hebrew) and Ein (Arabic) are the respective words for "spring.
